  - Jeremy Kitchen suggested we have daily announcements reminding people about the vote
  - Try appealing to the people that don't usually vote for Homecoming (i.e. Greeks, SGA)

Opened the floor to concerns about CCC

- Protection of weapons in dorms: hasn't been a problem at the campuses that allow CCC.
- Intoxicated persons with weapons: It is illegal for a CHL holder to carry his/her weapon while intoxicated
- Showing off weapons: It is illegal for a CHL holder to make it known he is carrying a gun
- Campuses will share strategies on how to handle all of these concerns and more.
